Club Ice Time Rules

- The Skating Club of Jackson Hole (SCJH) expects skaters, coaches and parents to be courteous and show good sportsmanship at all times
- Skaters/coaches must be cautious and aware of other skaters and their jumping patterns (see attached).
- Open After-School Freestyle sessions are for skaters currently enrolled in LTS, Bridge, and Advanced classes. Advanced sessions are only open to skaters currently enrolled in Advanced class (except Friday when Bridge joins).
- During sessions, skaters must wear a belt/sash when skating their program in a session with more than 5 skaters
- Food and/or drinks are not permitted on the ice (exception- plastic water bottles/non-breakable thermoses)
- It is the responsibility of all the skaters and coaches to keep the area clean. Remove all belongings (tissues, water bottles, gloves, coaches' books, etc.) before exiting the ice
- Do not stand on the ice unless against the boards
- Do not walk on the ice with shoes
- Guest private coaches/instructors:
 - Must be USFSA certified and compliant with USFSA insurance
 - Must supply to the Skating Director a copy of the coach's:
 - PSA insurance
 - Background check
 - SafeSport certification
 - SCJH guest coach agreement
 - Pay the required fee (20% of private lesson revenue unless other arrangements are approved by the SCJH Board)
 - All non-member requests to coach on club ice subject to review and approval by the Skating Director and SCJH Board
- Headphones are not allowed on the ice, excluding coaches working on choreography.
- Music Priority Rules:
 - Music will be played in the order in which it is laid out.
 - Music of skaters in a lesson wearing belt/sash has first priority
 - A skater may play their music once per session or until all skaters have had their music played
 - All programs will be played all the way through
- All the corners of the ice arena are assigned the "Lutz" zone. (see attached)
- The center of the ice arena is assigned the "spinning" zone. (see attached)
- Jump harness and other apparatus may be used on Freestyle Sessions, as long as they do not interfere with other skaters
- No group (more than 3 skaters) private lessons are allowed, with the exception of holiday show programs, LTS, mommy and me class, and all other group classes run by SCJH
- Video recording is not allowed from the bleachers or lobby without written prior approval from SCJH
- At the end of the session, skaters and coaches need to leave the ice promptly
