Please come dressed in your tights (and nude leotards if ordered). Your group number costumes will be placed in the locker room with your name on them. Aspire and Advanced skaters, you will change in the tunnel. Ensure you change into your assigned costume, putting the fuller skirt on first. Keep all locker room doors open at all times, and use the bathroom located in the lobby.

In summary: Wear tights, come to practice, find your costume. Practice starts at 11:30 PM for Advanced, 12:10 PM for Aspire/LTS solo skaters, and 12:45 PM for LTS Group number skaters.

Photos: Neil from Reaction Photos will be capturing off-the-ice photos for all skaters in the show in addition to on-ice photos. We kindly request that all skaters meet with Neil and their respective level/group at the following times:

Skaters should ensure their hair and makeup are done before arriving. They have the flexibility to style their hair and makeup in a manner that makes them feel confident, as long as it is kept away from their face. However, to maintain uniformity within the LTS group numbers, please refrain from using large bows in your hair.

Exhibition STARTS at $\mathbf{1 : 3 0} \mathbf{p m}$ on $\mathbf{3 / 1 0}$. I highly recommend assisting your skater in using the bathroom and having a quick snack after they finish their photos or practice. Skaters should report to their designated 'side' by 1:25 PM.All LTS skaters will enter and exit on the north side, while Aspire and Advanced skaters will use the Zam side.

It is crucial to note that the exhibition will commence promptly. Once your skater is ready, check in with the coach in charge (Coach Stephanie, Becky, Emma, Lynn \& Joci on the North Side and Coach Anna and Abby on the Zam Side). After that, parents are free to leave until after their skater's second skate (they will come out for the opening and then their group number).

After the LTS group number (not the opening), please come find them and allow them to watch the remainder of the first half with you in the stands. Once intermission is over, bring them back, change their skirts (put on the less full skirt), and check back in with the coach to ask when they would like you to bring the skater back to be ready for their next performance. In total, your skater will perform twice in the first half and twice in the second half.
*Aspire/Advanced and solo skaters I ask that you keep track of where we are in the schedule and to be backstage, ready to skate with a minimum of two skaters before you. Abby and Ann should not have to track you down!
