

MAKE SHOW TIME EASY INSTRUCTIONS: The More, The Merrier: Invite all your friends and family! This show isn't just for skaters—it's a fun event for everyone. As a friendly reminder, all parents and siblings will need a ticket or wristband to enter the building on show day, including during practice. Please plan accordingly and purchase your tickets early! **We kindly ask parents not to reserve large sections of seating with blankets, especially for groups of skaters, as this can leave seats unused.** Last year, many reserved seats went empty, and we'd love to avoid that this year. **Lastly, due to SafeSport regulations, anyone over the age of 18 is not permitted in the tunnel where skaters are changing. If your skater needs assistance, please have them come out to meet you.**

Dress Rehearsal 12/5: The dress rehearsal is scheduled for Friday, December 5th. We kindly request all skaters to arrive and be ready to go by 4:45 pm and enter the building through the cast entrance doors to check in and receive a wristband. Skaters should be dressed in their tights and nude leotards (if ordered) .

Girls Aspire and AA will dress in the tunnel and boys will have an assigned locker room on the other end. We ask all aspire and AA to stay in your skating pants and jackets for the first 30 min to stay warm. After the first 30 min of joint practice with LTS, Aspire and AA will then change quickly into your first costume we then will do a full run through of the show with costume changes. After the practice, ensure that you hang your costume and place your labeled costume bag over it. Do not take the costume home; make sure the bag is properly labeled. Keep all locker room doors always open, and skaters should use the bathroom located in the lobby.

SHOW DAY/s: We have two shows scheduled, an evening performance on Saturday, 12/6, at 5:00 pm, and a matinee on Sunday at 12:30 pm. **I strongly recommend that skaters arrive 60-45 minutes early for each show. Skaters and ticketed parents are asked to enter through the cast door and check in. Skaters and parents will need to check in and get stamped before entering the building on show day including before practice ice.** It is crucial to note that the shows will commence promptly at the scheduled start time.

Skaters should ensure that their hair and makeup are done before arriving. They have the flexibility to style their hair and makeup in a manner that makes them feel confident, as long as hair is kept out of their face.. **Coach Anna, Emma L. and Becky are your go to coaches backstage.**
