

MAKE SHOW TIME EASY INSTRUCTIONS: The More, The Merrier: Please invite all your friends and family! This show isn't just for skaters; it's a fun event for everyone! **As a friendly reminder, all parents and siblings will need a ticket or wristband to enter the building on show day.** Please plan accordingly and purchase your tickets EARLY!!!!

LTS- Will continue their show practice next week on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:45-4.00pm up to the dress rehearsal. There is last Sunday Practices for LTS skaters is on 11/16.

Dress Rehearsal 12/5: The dress rehearsal is scheduled for Friday, December 5th. We kindly request all skaters to arrive by no later than 3:45 pm and enter the building through the cast entrance doors to check in (and receive their nude wristband). Skaters should be dressed in their tights and nude leotards (if ordered) and boys in their black pants. LTS practice/Dress rehearsal will start at 4:00pm.

Girls dresses and boys Shirts will be placed in the locker room with your name on them. Please change into your assigned costume putting the sparkly skirt on first - boys will put their shirt on only first(vest will go second), we kindly ask that skaters changing who don't have a nude leotard change in the bathroom. After the practice, ensure that you hang your costume and place your labeled costume bag over it. Do not take the costume home; make sure the bag is properly labeled. Keep all locker room doors always open, and skaters should use the bathroom located in the lobby. **To summarize: Wear tights, come to practice, find your costume, practice starts at 4:00 pm and runs until approximately 5:15 pm for Learn to skate skaters and 7:00pm for Advanced and Aspire. Leave your labeled costume with the bag on top.**

SHOW DAY/s: We have two shows scheduled, an evening performance on Saturday, 12/6, at 5:00 pm, and a matinee on Sunday at 12:30 pm. **I strongly recommend that skaters arrive 60-45 minutes early for each show. Skaters and ticketed parents are asked to enter through the cast door and check in. Skaters and parents will need to show their wristbands to enter the building on show day.** It is crucial to note that the shows will commence promptly at the scheduled start time.

Skaters should ensure that their hair and makeup are done before arriving. They have the flexibility to style their hair and makeup in a manner that makes them feel confident, as long as hair is kept out of their face. However, to maintain uniformity within the group, please refrain from using large bows, crowns in their hair and face paint/ festival face gems. In addition girl skaters will not be allowed to preform with different colored tights, colored base layers or colored gloves. **Please make sure you have nude skating tights and if your girl skaters desire a nude leotard and nude gloves.** Boys are asked to wear black pants and we will provide their tops.

Step By Step On Show Day: Upon arrival through the cast door/check in, skaters should pass through the Drop-off curtain (to the right after the stairs). Help your skater locate their costume and put on their skates (they should already have their nude leotard on or change in the bathroom). Once your skater is ready, check in with the coach in charge (Coach Stephanie, Allyson & Lynn). After that, parents are free to leave until after their skater's second skate (they will come out for the opening and then their group number).

During the first half, your skater will participate in two numbers: the opening and their group number. After their group number (not the opening), we will ask you to return to the Drop-off curtain/locker room area. Please pick them up at this point, allowing them to watch the remainder of the first half with you in the stands.

Once intermission is over (unless otherwise instructed by the coaches), bring them back, change their skirts (put on the less full skirt and boys change your top), and check back in with the coach. From this point, they will remain backstage for their second group performance and the closing. In total, your skater will perform twice in the first half and twice in the second half.

Don't forget to bring layers, coats, gloves, and blankets to keep the kids warm on Show Day!
